



Scholarly Electronic Journals for the Health Sciences

Electronic journals that have been licensed by CWRU are available to faculty, students and staff on campus by faceplate and off campus or wireless access by using VPN, or if the journals are from the OhioLINK EJC, through remote authentication. Not every journal is available electronically. Of those that are electronic, CWRU does not subscribe to every electronic journal. Most electronic journals became available in the mid 1990's. Some have retrospectively converted older volumes from print only to electronic as well. For many journals which are now available electronically, CHSL has cancelled the print subscriptions, usually because of the costs.

Links to electronic journals are available from most of the databases used by CWRU.

Some are linked through EuclidPLUS. Some are linked through the alphabetical list from CWRU. Some work from the links in the databases.

In the health sciences, please start at the homepage of the Cleveland Health Sciences Library:

where there are links to electronic journals as well as to the databases which have links to electronic journals. In addition, there are links to aggregators which are large collections of electronic journals usually searchable by topic, author, etc.

You must have at the very least the free reader from Adobe:

At CWRU, you may download the professional reader from the Software Center:

Among other features, the professional version allows you to export images from .pdf's further allowing you to use them in other applications.

The DOI System is for identifying content objects in the digital environment. Many articles that are EPUB AHEAD OF PRINT are sometimes difficult to locate. There are neither

volume nor issue numbers, which most online vendors use to link citations to electronic articles. If you know the DOI number you may be able to find an article by using the DOI number in the DOI Resolver:

Click on everything available until there is nothing left to click. If you are properly connected (the journal recognizes that you are from CWRU – by IP address), you should be able to view all journals to which you are entitled. If you are asked for an ID and Password, and/or money, CWRU does not subscribe to the journal.
