

## Class of 2017 Match Timeline (University Program)

<b>Year 2</b>	
September 17, 2014	Begin planning what happens after the end of block 6: Class Meeting to make choices about March-July 2015 (Step I, research block, early clinical rotations)
October 2014	Order of core clinical rotations are assigned. Student switches until 11/15/14
November 10, 2014	Lottery for early (March-July 2015) clinical core rotations.
January 2015	Submit preferences for sites of clinical core rotations, assignments occur 8 weeks before the start of the core with a 1 week period for student switches
March 2, 2015	Block 6 ends
March- July 2015	Options: USMLE Step I, Research block, early clinical core

July 2015-July 2016	Clinical Cores 1-4, research/flexible time
December 31, 2015	Deadline for taking USMLE Step 1
January 2016	Class Meeting about scheduling AIs and Electives
February 1, 2016	Official scheduling for AIs & Electives that begin in July will start on Feb. 1 <sup>st</sup>

Spring-Fall, 2016	Register for Early Match Specialties (Ophthalmology, Urology) and Military Matches
June, 2016	Third year ends for most students
<b>Year 4</b>	
Mid-April, 2016	Obtain ERAS token (special code) from registrar; start working on your myERAS application
Mid-August, 2016	Register with NRMP for the Main Residency Match (Registrar will notify students)
September 15, 2016	Submit ERAS Application. Students may start applying to specific programs and programs may contact individual applicants via ERAS for interviews
October 1, 2016	Medical Student Performance Evaluation (MSPE) “Dean’s Letter” uploaded to ERAS
November 1, 2016	Deadline for taking USMLE Step 2 CS (University Program)
November 30, 2016	NRMP registration deadline. \$50 late fee afterwards
Mid-December 2016	Military Match
Early January 2017	Urology Match: deadline for submission of rank list, results late-January <a href="http://www.aunet.org/">http://www.aunet.org/</a>
January 2017	Ophthalmology Match (SF Match) deadline for submitting rank list, results mid-January <a href="https://www.sfmatch.org/">https://www.sfmatch.org/</a>
Mid-January 2017	Applicants and programs may start entering their rank order lists at 12:00 noon eastern time
January 31, 2017	Deadline for taking USMLE Step 2 CK (University Program)
Late February, 2017	Final NRMP match lists due for applicants and programs before 9:00am eastern time
Oct. 2016 – Jan. 2017	Residency interviews
March 13, 2017 *	SOAP (Supplemental Offer and Accept Program) Begins
March 17, 2017 *	Match Day
April – May 2017	Sign the contract with your residency program
May 21, 2017	Medical School Graduation
June 2017	Residency begins
